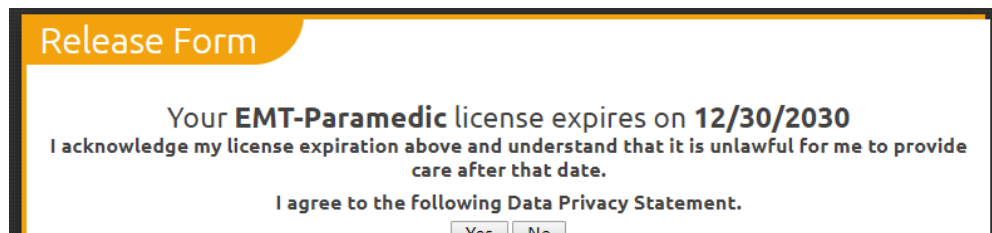

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Effective July 1, 2019, faxed, mailed and dropped off paperwork will no longer be accepted. The new procedure for submitting paperwork for paramedic continuous accreditation is to **email required documents to emscerts@marincounty.org**. You will receive an automatic reply confirming receipt of your submission.

Letters and stickers will no longer be issued; an email confirming your new date will be sent within 30 days of receiving a complete continuous accreditation application.

To confirm accreditation status, one can log into ImageTrend Elite **web version** (<https://marincounty.imagetrendelite.com/Elite/Organizationmarincounty/>) where the expiration date will be shown.
